To the Minneapolis Park Board of Commissioners,

I am formally requesting that the Minneapolis Park Board of Commissioners amend the title of Resolution 2017-243 to conform to the changes made to that resolution on October 4, 2017.

At the first Hiawatha Golf Course Community Advisory Committee meeting on March 28, 2018, the committee members were told that they could not consider "perpetuation of current uses" of the Hiawatha Golf Course property as stated in the CAC Charge of Resolution 2017-355. The reason given was because the Title of Resolution 2017-243 still references the "reduced pumping scenario" even though the language was struck out of the Resolved portion of Resolution 2017-243 on October 4, 2017.

In fact, the title of Resolution 2017-243 contains the exact language that was struck from the Resolved portion of the resolution on October 4, 2017.

This appears to be an omission by the previous Board of Commissioners, and needs to be rectified by the current Board of Commissioners so that the Hiawatha Golf Course CAC can fulfill its Charge as stated in Resolution 2017-355.

Please amend the title of Resolution 2017-243 before the next meeting of the Hiawatha Golf Course CAC on April 30, 2018.
